GUILTON & NEW STREET, ASH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to install village gateways with associated signage and road markings, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of New Street and Gilton, Ash, near Sandwich, as detailed below.

GUILTON will be closed west of the junction with Durlock Road as shown on site.

Continuous closure from Monday 26 October 2020 for 2 days

The alternative route is via Pedding Hill, A257 Ash Bypass and Chequer Lane

NEW STREET will be closed south of the junction with Saunders Lane, to the extent indicated on site.

Closure Thursday 29 October 2020 for 1 day

The alternative route is via The Street, Gilton, Durlock Road, Lower Road, Fleming Road, Drainless Road, Beacon Lane and Marshborough Road
