CHEQUER LANE, ASH, SANDWICH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out junction modifications and improvements in connection with a new development, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Chequer Lane, Ash, near Sandwich.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 25 October 2021 for an estimated period of up to 2 weeks.

Chequer Lane will be closed south of the junction with Queens Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A257 Ash Bypass, Pedding Hill, Gilton and The Street.

Local access to the remainder of Chequer Lane continues from a southern direction up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
